ABCC Applicants with Disabilities

In accordance with the ADA, where feasible, the ABPN's public services are administered in a manner that best ensures equal access to individuals with documented qualifying disabilities who demonstrate and request a need for accommodation(s) or auxiliary aides, provided that the requested accommodation is reasonable, not unduly burdensome and does not fundamentally alter the measurement of the skills or knowledge being assessed.

As such, requests for changes in the duration of a 3-year block, extensions to a 3-year block, the number of article exams needing to be successfully completed or any other alteration in the grading or assessment will be deemed to fundamentally alter the measurement of the skills or knowledge being assessed and will not be granted by the ABPN.

Individuals seeking appropriate ADA accommodations should complete and submit the ABPN's <u>Application</u> <u>for Testing Accommodations</u>.

As a one-time exception, those participating in ABCC during the 2022-2024 and 2023-2025 3-year blocks will be allowed to submit their applications for Testing Accommodations through April 1, 2024.

For those beginning ongoing participation in ABCC in 2024 and later, completed applications for testing accommodations must be received by February 1, of the year they enter the ABCC pathway and on February 1 of every 3-year block.
